First read the wall text for each exhibition, then follow the steps below to guide your art viewing experience.

1 Look: Take time to identify what you observe and look at the artwork.

2 **See:** Create a list of the visual elements. Seeing involves recognizing or connecting the information the eyes take in.

Describe: Identify and organize your thoughts about what you have seen.

Analyze: Use your description and apply reason, consider how the elements you identified in your description relate to tell a story.

5 Interpret: Draw conclusions about the artwork, using your descriptions and analysis.
