

# Visiting NSU Art Museum

NSU Art Museum is  
located in Downtown  
Fort Lauderdale. The  
area has lots of cars and

Parking is available on the street on SE 1st Ave or in the Riverwalk Center Parking Garage. Parking for both can be paid for at a kiosk or through the PaybyPhone app.



We will find a pedestrian crossing and cross SE 1st Ave towards the museum.



We will continue south  
towards Las Olas  
Boulevard.



When we reach the intersection of SE 1st Ave and Las Olas Blvd we will turn right and continue east towards the entrance fo the museum.



We can use the stairs or the ramp to continue to the entrance.




Explore the museum

At the end of my visit, I will have my large bag returned to me in exchange for the small ticket.



Lastly, before I start my visit, I will be offered a Sensory Bag filled with headphones. I can ask for a bag at any point in my visit from the front desk.



Now that I am done at the front desk, I can follow the arrows on the floor to lead me to the different art activities, or I can walk off of the path and use the stairs and elevators to explore the exhibitions on the first and second floor.



When I'm investigating the exhibitions, I will stand back, and away from the artwork.



Some of the art I see may be on a pedestal, on the floor, on the ceiling, framed on the wall, or the art may be the wall itself. I will be mindful of my body and the space I am in.



If I am feeling overwhelmed  
and need a quiet area, I can find  
one outside on the first floor  
across the breeze way in the  
auditorium.



When I reach an art activity,  
I will be greeted by a staff  
member and invited to make  
some art. I can ask the staff  
member for help, and I can  
follow the Task Analysis  
provided to help me complete  
my art activity.



When I am done investigating the exhibitions, I can go back to the lobby to find the café and gift shop to buy food or a gift.



A café and gift shop staff member will be available if I need help with anything at 10 AM.



When I am done at the café and gift shop, I can then return to the front desk to exchange my small ticket for my large bag or other personal items I've left there.



Your visit has concluded! Make your way to the exit, the same place where you entered. We hope you enjoyed your visit to NSU Art Museum Fort Lauderdale.
