
Visiting NSU Art Museum

I will use my:










Walking Feet, Listening Ears, Inside voice, Calm Body

My school group and I will be led by our docent through the exhibitions. We can ask our Docent questions, but we will raise our hand and wait to be called on before we ask.








When we are investigating the exhibitions, we will stay with our group, and we will stand back and away from the artwork.







We will follow our docent and use the stairs or elevator to explore the exhibitions on first and second floors.








